All About NPQLT

Our NPQs work on a cyclical basis using a hybrid model of delivery. Participants are invited to attend 8 online sessions, 4 face-to-face sessions and 4 online group coaching sessions.

The programmes are underpinned by a wealth of well-constructed self-study materials which provide access to the rich evidence base on which the frameworks are constructed. Sessions are delivered by expert facilitators who are able to share their knowledge and experience in leading teaching. This programme is ideal for subject or phase leads.

The Delivery Model

NPQLTD spans 4 teaching cycles over 12 months.
Each cycle has 5 stages.

PREPARE > ACTIVATE > TEACH > PRACTICE > APPLY

1. PREPARE

- One or two small key documents to read
- One or two small reflection questions
- Takes 30 minutes

2. ACTIVATE

- 90 minute online session, delivered nationally by CEFEL
- Introduces the Learn That statements and unpicks some in depth
- Encourages participants to make links between the new unit and the previous unit

3. TEACH

- 3 hours asynchronous study, per unit
- Covers ALL of the Learn That statements in detail
- Completed online as an interactive learning package

4. PRACTICE

- 2 hour coaching session, per teaching cycle, delivered online by Redhill
- In small groups of 6-8 participants
- Looking in depth at how participants can take their learning and use it to have the greatest impact in their school

5. APPLY

- Half day, face-to-face teaching
- Delivered locally by Redhill at Redhill Trust Training Centre
- Introduces the Learn How to Statements - focus on practical application
